Our voices naturally change, but if you have it your heart to sing a certain range, then I suggest you start warming up that voice. :-)

For those of you who remember last year, being indoors will be a major improvement. However, masks are still an annoyance to sing in UNLESS you take the time to identify the perfect singing mask. I strongly recommend that you investigate different styles of mask as no two designs or faces are the same. Personally, I prefer a mask that covers more of my face, creates a pocket in front of my lips, and has toggles for adjusting the tightness. When you are done singing, it is likely that your mask will become damp and gross. It would be wise to have a handful of masks that are set aside for choir class only.
