Course Description: The purpose of this class is to provide young men and women the opportunity to explore their singing voice in a fun and comfortable environment. This class is geared towards refining the advanced voice and will introduce dedicated singers to a variety of musical styles and genres. Students will be expected to positively participate by having their music and pencil ready, and by singing when asked to do so.

Course Objectives: With the national and state music education standards in mind, students in U-Prep music classes will have solo and ensemble performance opportunities. In preparation for these performances, students will focus on proper sound production techniques, sight reading, basic piano skills, basic music theory, music history, and musical creativity.

Grading Criteria: Class Performance: 50%
Assignments: 25%
Concerts: 25%

We will be spending most of our time in preparation for concerts and performances. **Attendance and participation at these functions are essential and carry a heavier weight. Missing one concert may result in a “C” or lower for the semester.**
