- Course Objectives: With the national and state music education standards in mind, students in U-Prep music classes will have solo and ensemble performance opportunities. In preparation for these performances, students will focus on proper sound production techniques, sight reading, music theory, music history, and musical creativity.

As an ensemble class, it is important for students to continue to be inclusive regardless of physical location. Online communication will be essential to overall success.
